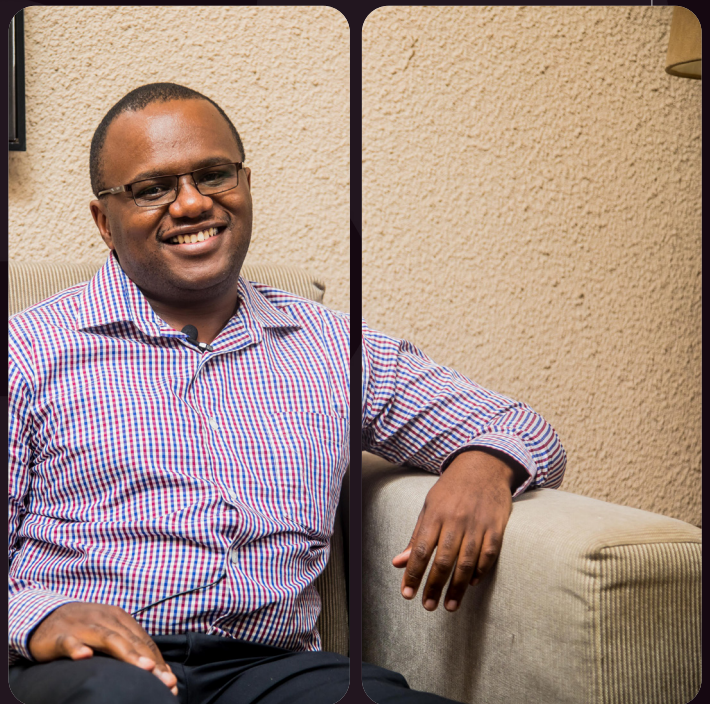

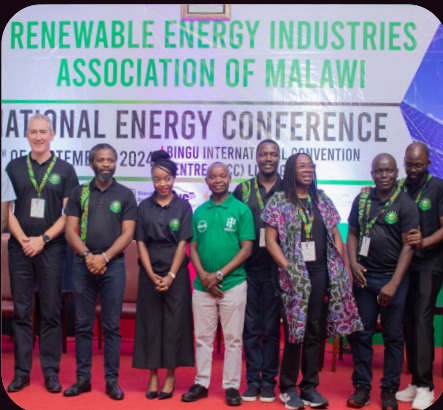
MESCH AT ECAP WORKSHOPS
